



INFORMATION ABOUT DISASTER RISKS IN UZBEKISTAN

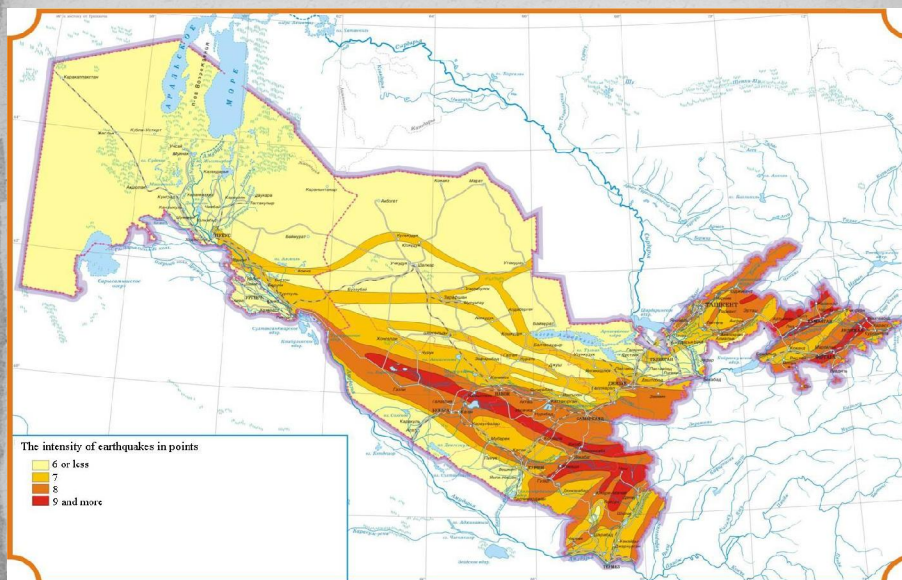
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In accordance with the Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan in 1996 was created the Ministry of Emergency Situations of the Republic of Uzbekistan

The main areas of the Ministry of Emergency Situations in protecting population and territories from disasters, are:

- *expansion of the monitoring system, ensuring accuracy of forecast, early adoption of preventive measures and elimination of the consequences of the emergency situations;*
- *improvement and ensuring the reliability of warning and communication systems in the event of emergency situations threats;*
- *prompt response and adequate measures for emergency situations;*
- *comprehensive training of population, targeted training of forces in the mean of emergency situations.*

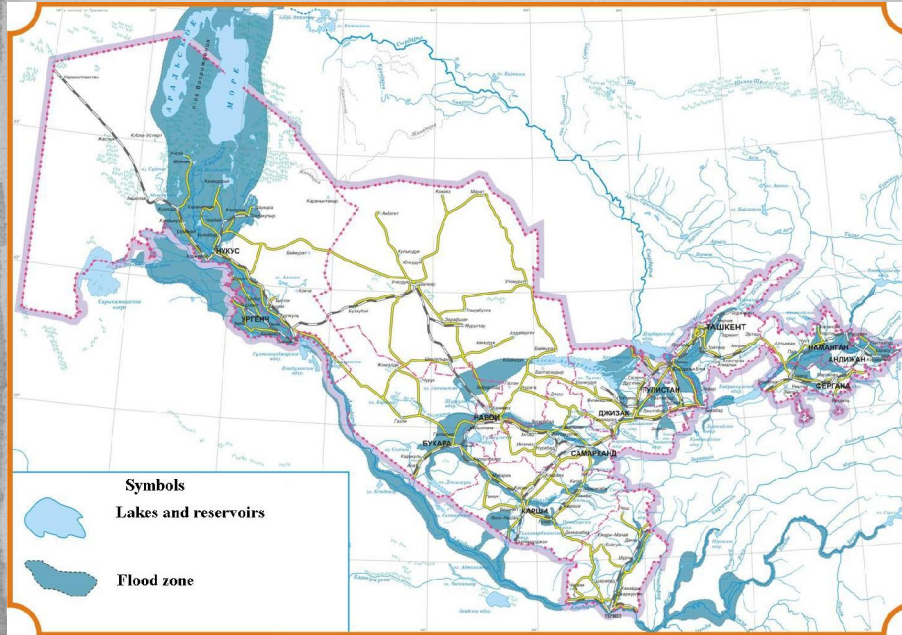
MAP OF SEISMIC ZONES IN THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN



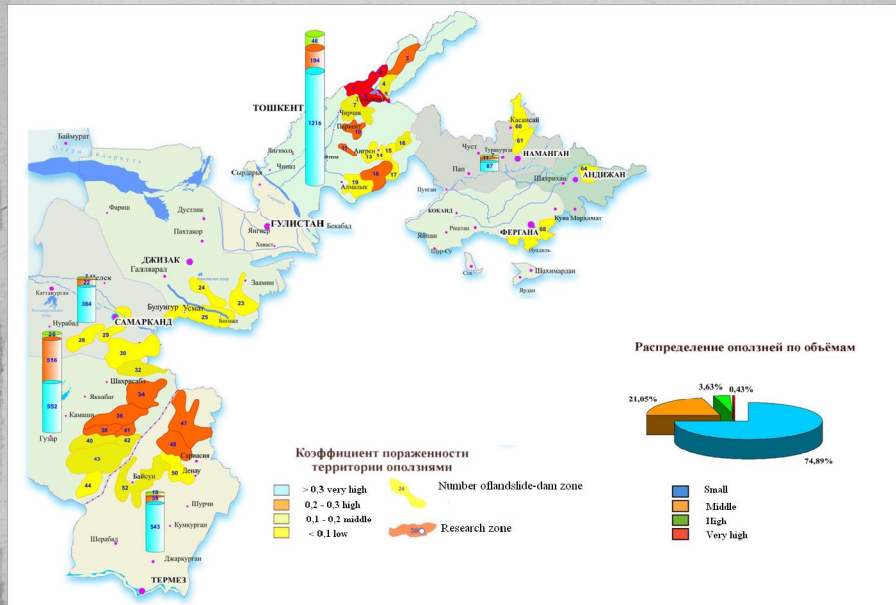
SEISMIC MONITORING OF EARTHQUAKES FROM 2006 TILL 2009

- **CIS** «Agreement on Cooperation in the field of preventing and eliminating effects of natural and man-made emergency situations» 22.01.1993.
- **Russia** «Agreement between Uzbekistan and Russia on cooperation in prevention and response of emergency situations» 06.05.1998.
- **Central Asia** «Agreement between Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan on cooperation in prevention and response of emergency situations» 17.07.1998.
- **Tajikistan** «Agreement between Uzbekistan and Tajikistan on joint activities and cooperation in the matter on early warning in case of Sarez Lake breakthrough» 30.05.2000.
- **SCO** «Agreement between the SCO member states on cooperation in providing assistance in the emergency situations» 26.10.2005.
- **Ukraine** «Agreement between Uzbekistan and Ukraine on cooperation in prevention and response of emergency situations» 26.04.2007.
